

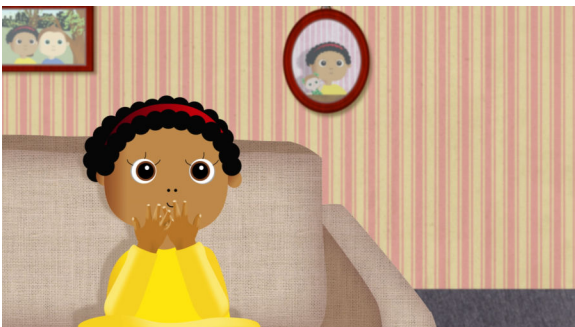
Binti and the picture of Granddad



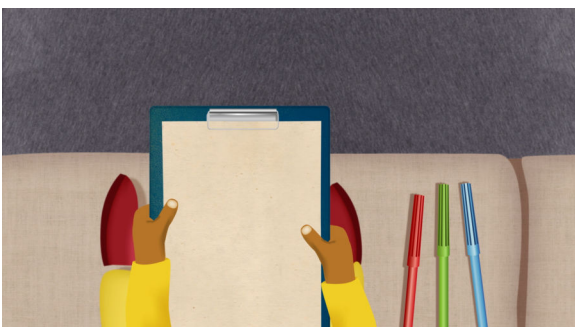
Binti and Mummy are in the living room.

What shall I draw? she asks Granddad.



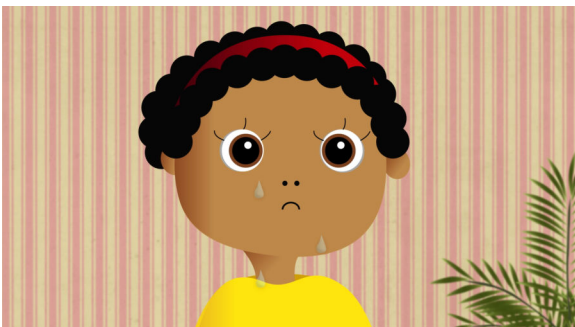
But Granddad doesn't look happy.
