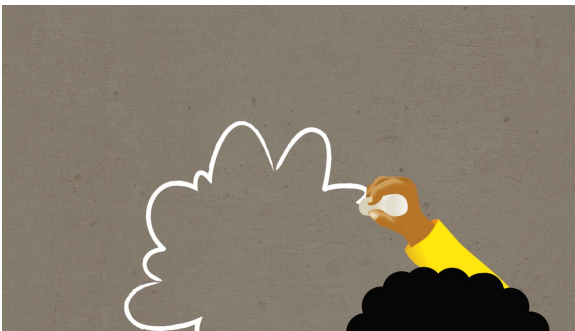


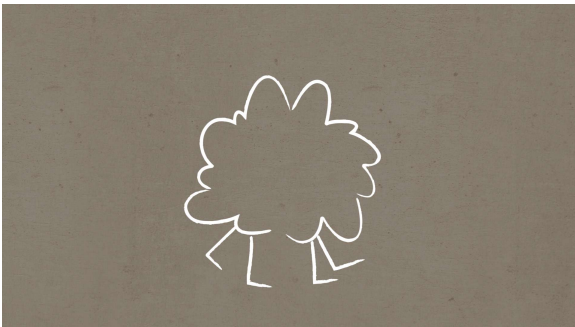
Binti has got a piece of chalk

All done!



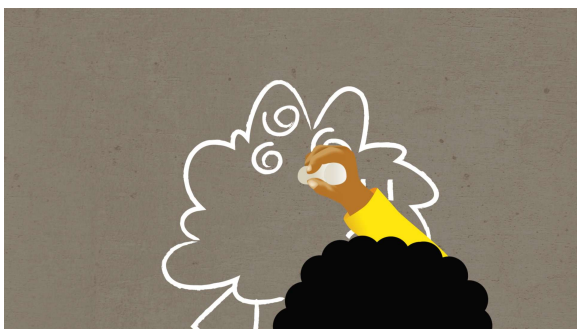
O you are a pretty sheep, says Binti.
