The water is wet.



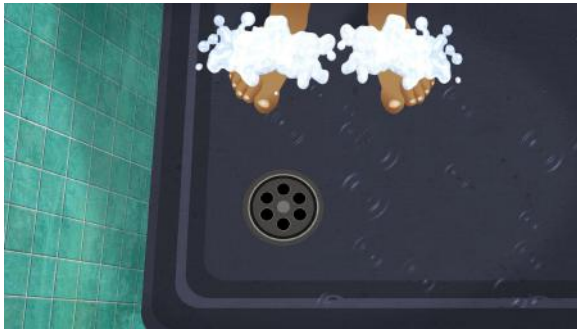
Mummy squirts shampoo on Binti's head.

There is soap on the cloth.



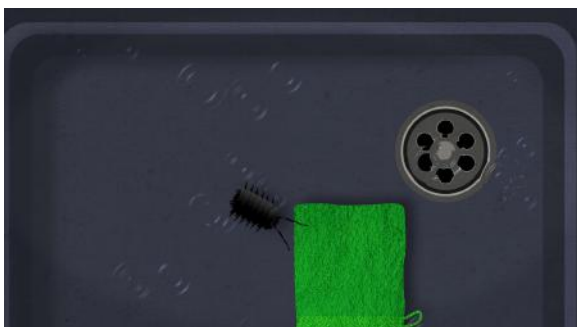
Binti has a good wash.
