

Boris and the washing machine



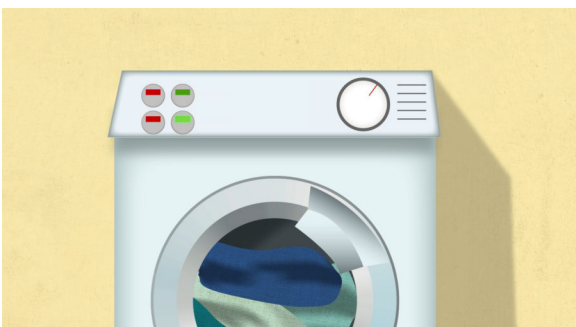
Boris is sitting on the bathroom floor.

He puts the red towel on the red pile.



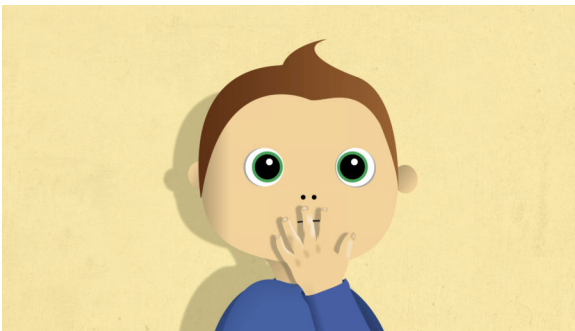
There is Bear.
